



School Advisory Board Nomination Form

The St. Joseph School Advisory Board is comprised of twelve voting members, our principal and pastor. Of the voting members, there are six elected and six appointed. All members serve a three year term. Terms are staggered so that each year four new members join the board as four members complete their term.

The Board is responsible for establishing the philosophy and goals of our school's educational programs, interpreting and applying Archdiocese policies as they relate to Catholic education and formulating additional policies as necessary. The Board is also responsible for long-range planning and community relations. Its members serve and/or lead a number of committees including the school's marketing committee, development committee, technology committee, chastity committee, and safety committee. Members also serve as liaisons for parishioner and parent input regarding the school's policies and operations.

Nominations for the School Advisory Board are now open.

There are three board member terms expiring the June, 2011. Nominations for these terms are now open. Board members must be 21 years of age or older and a registered St. Joseph parishioner or a parent of a student enrolled in St. Joseph School. Any parent, parishioner, teacher or school/parish staff member may submit a nomination. Nominee profiles will be published in the Thursday Notes. Election voting is scheduled for the weekend of May 12-14th – May 21st.
